16-11-03      Regarding Ad Valorem Property Tax to be Levied in 2017

Mayor Vradenburg opened the Public Hearing at 7:05pm.

Mayor Vradenburg said the 2017 Budget would include the one percent allowable property tax increase, plus new construction. The total amount budgeted would be \$176,243.92. This amount would be split 75/25 between the Current Expense Fund 001 and the Street Fund 101.

**Council Action:** A motion was made by Councilmember Marshall, second by Councilmember Stenberg to adopt Ordinance 2016-766 fixing the amount of ad valorem taxes to be levied for the City of Entiat, Washington, for the year 2017. Councilmember Przespolewski requested a copy of the SCJ Alliance 2017 proposal.


Hearing no public comment, Mayor Vradenburg closed the Public Hearing at 7:27pm.
